

The words you need to make your gift unforgettable



To include Action for Children in your will, you might find it helpful to take along the following legal wording when you visit your solicitor. This should ensure your wishes are followed accurately:

Residuary bequest (a share of your estate)

My bequest to Action for Children of the residual estate (or a proportion of) – a residuary or percentage legacy:

“Subject to the payment of my debts, funeral and testamentary expenses, I give the whole (residuary) or _____% of my estate not otherwise disposed of by this my will to Action for Children (Registered charity numbers 1097940 (England) and SC038092 (Scotland)) of 3 The Boulevard, Ascot Road, Watford WD18 8AG, for the general purposes of Action for Children and I declare that the receipt of their Treasurer or other proper officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge.”

Pecuniary bequest (a specific sum of money)

My bequest to Action for Children for a set sum – a pecuniary legacy:

“I give free of tax to Action for Children (Registered charity numbers 1097940 (England) and SC038092 (Scotland)) of 3 The Boulevard, Ascot Road, Watford WD18 8AG, the sum of £_____ for the general purposes of Action for Children and I declare that the receipt of their Treasurer or other proper officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge.”
