What We Do...

- We provide activity based parenting sessions for families affected by substance misuse which will enable parents to engage more positively with their children. This will improve the quality of attachments between the parent and child and enhance the parent's self-esteem, confidence and parenting ability.
- Age appropriate play will enhance the child's overall physical, emotional and cognitive development.
- We can offer short periods of childcare whilst the parent attends necessary appointments in some circumstances.
- We work holistically in partnership with local agencies to improve outcomes for children and their families.
- We strive to enhance the life chances of very young children while simultaneously giving parents confidence and raising self-esteem.
- We aim to enhance parenting skills and help parents to develop positive attachments with their children, therefore preventing the risk of family breakdown.

- We equip parents with parenting strategies which they can adapt and use as the child grows up.



Mellow Parenting...

Mellow Parenting is a 14 week course delivered within a group setting. It is designed to support and build parents confidence in parenting and make positive changes in their relationship with their children. The groups run in groups with just mums or just dads and with a child under 5 years old.



Positive Parenting Programme...

The Positive Parenting Program, or Triple P, is a multi-level system of family intervention for parents of children who have or are at risk of developing behaviour problems.

It is a preventively orientated program which aims to promote positive, caring relationships between parents and their children, and to help parents develop effective management strategies for dealing with a variety of childhood behaviour problems and common developmental issues.

Referrals...

Referrals can be made via Social Work, Health Visitors, Midwives, Education and self-referrals. After the initial referral a family support practitioner will arrange a visit with you to assess your needs. We work with children from the age of 0-8 years.
